Who We Are

About Us

We are a Colorado-based nonprofit charitable organization that operates to reduce harm, preserve dignity, and protect life for individuals experiencing homelessness, particularly those living with serious mental illness and substance use disorders.

The organization carries out its mission through direct outreach and mobile services, including the distribution of essential survival gear (such as backpacks, tents, tarps, coats, shoes, socks, and hygiene kits), harm reduction resources, and transportation services that facilitate access to sanitation, laundry, recovery, and housing resources.

The organization also provides consistent wellness check-ins, suicide awareness and prevention efforts, and crisis intervention support for individuals at high risk of overdose or mental health crises, building trust through nonjudgmental, person-centered care. Services are provided without requiring sobriety or behavior change as a condition of support, with the goal of helping individuals survive long enough to choose what comes next.
